Clean recycling is good recycling

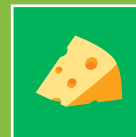

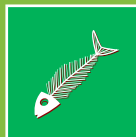
No thanks

- ✗ Plastic bags, film wrapping, video tapes, DVDs, children's toys or electrical items
- ✗ Nappies, syringes or needles
- ✗ Window glass, Pyrex or cookware
- ✗ Paint tins, gas bottles or helium gas canisters
- ✗ Wet or dirty food stained card like pizza boxes
- ✗ General rubbish, black bag waste, garden furniture
- ✗ Wood, garden waste, food waste
- ✗ Clothing, shoes, bags or suitcases

Recycle your food waste weekly - Use your small caddy to collect the food waste in the kitchen. You can line it with any plastic bag. Put this in the larger outdoor caddy and we'll collect it on the same day as your blue or green bin. Simple! Please remember, only food waste – no animal or pet waste.

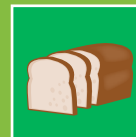

Your green refuse bin is for everything that cannot be recycled in your blue bin, brown bin or food caddy. On collection day, your green bin lid must be able to close.
